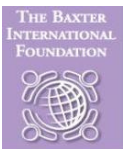

**Dr. Richard David** is an attending neonatologist and co-director of the neonatal intensive care unit at Stroger Hospital of Cook County. His clinical work involves care for newborns from a low-income minority and immigrant population in Chicago. His research has focused on perinatal epidemiology and more specifically on the relation between social inequality – especially racism in its various forms – and birth outcomes.



In addition to his “day job” in academic medicine, he has been active in different organizations working for social justice. This includes a variety of things ranging from street protests opposing healthcare cuts or police violence to marches opposing the US invasion of Iraq and Afghanistan. He was instrumental in raising opposition to the wars inside the American Public Health Association where anti-war resolutions he sponsored became Association policy.

Dr. David was also featured in an episode of *Unnatural Causes*, a documentary first aired on PBS that explores root causes of our alarming socio-economic and racial inequities in health.
